



Can students extend their stay?	Yes.
Specific requirements for extending stay:	A request must be lodged at least 1 month prior to the start of the semester with the academic mobility coordinator.

Enrolment	The International Relations Service will submit your Learning Agreement for enrolment once it has been approved by both parties: the home and host universities. The Secretariat-General is responsible for formalising enrolment.
Changes to the Learning Agreement	Once classes start, students will have between 10 and 15 days to make changes to the subjects in which they are enrolled. How to proceed: 1. Contact your academic coordinator at UIC Barcelona 2. If your academic coordinator at UIC Barcelona approves the changes, contact your academic coordinator at your home university 3. If the academic coordinator at your home university approves the changes, you must enter the changes as instructed: • Erasmus studies mobility students: see document "OLA instructions for incoming Erasmus students" • Erasmus traineeships/bilateral/visiting/SICUE mobility students: see document "How to prepare your LA in Relint 3.0" Following the deadline. no changes to the Learning Agreement will be accepted.

Certificates	An official language certificate is required, otherwise, the certificate must be issued by a language school, or a language professor/department from your home university → Certificates obtained by taking the Erasmus OLS Mobility Test will not be accepted.
